

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
CROOKED LANE, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025


NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Crooked Lane, Preston from its junction with Tithebarn Street to outside of number 18 Crooked Lane.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Wednesday 5th March 2025 until Tuesday 11th March 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Tithebarn Street – North Road – Ring Way – Church Street – Lancaster Road – Crooked Lane.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new electrical connection works to be carried out.
