CROOKED LANE, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Crooked Lane, Preston from its junction with Tithebarn Street to outside of number 18 Crooked Lane.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> March 2025 until Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> March 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Tithebarn Street – North Road – Ring Way – Church Street – Lancaster Road – Crooked Lane.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new electrical connection works to be carried out.
