(WARDLEYS LANE, STALMINE WITH STAYNALL, WYRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY ONE-WAY PROHIBITION) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed **in a southerly direction** over that length of Wardleys Lane, Stalmine with Staynall for its entire length from its junction with Staynall Lane to its junction with Kiln Lane.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Thursday 13th March 2025 until 1700 hours on Friday 1st August 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Staynall Lane – Carr Lane – Kiln Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow safe access for works traffic to be carried out by Morgan Sindall.
