## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(WARDLEYS LANE, STALMINE WITH STAYNALL, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY ONE-WAY PROHIBITION) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed **in a southerly direction** over that length of Wardleys Lane, Stalmine with Staynall for its entire length from its junction with Staynall Lane to its junction with Kiln Lane.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> March 2025 until 1700 hours on Friday 1<sup>st</sup> August 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Staynall Lane – Carr Lane – Kiln Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow safe access for works traffic to be carried out by Morgan Sindall.
