
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Granville Road, Heysham from its junction with Fairfield Road to its junction with Back Fairfield Road North.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> March 2025 until 1700 hours on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> March 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access for emergency service vehicles will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-  
Fairfield Road – Westminster Road – Stanley Road – Granville Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Network Plus to replace Linkbox in the footway on behalf of Electricity North West.
