
(REAR 17-61 SACKVILLE STREET, BRIERFIELD, PENDLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Rear 17 61 Sackville Street, Brierfield from its junction with Albion Street to the rear of 41 Sackville Street.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 18th March 2025 until 1700 hours on Thursday 20th March 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Albion Street – Sackville Street – Gable End 61 Sackville Street and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow to installation of shorted sided connection and to disconnect the old lead supply to be carried out.
