(C105 SCHOOL LANE, DOWNHOLLAND, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of C105 School Lane, Downholland from the southwestern boundary of property number 163 to a point 35m North of the northern boundary of property number 143.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily between 0930 hours and 1500 hours from Monday 10th March 2025 until Friday 14th March 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained at all times.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

C105 School Lane, Downholland – C104 School Lane, Downholland –
A5147 Delf Lane, Downholland – C105 Black-a-Moor Lane,
Downholland – C105 School Lane, Downholland and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new ducting installation works to be carried out by Sunbelt Rentals Ltd in conjunction with BT.
