(C137 FISH LANE, BURSCOUGH AND C137 BERRY HOUSE ROAD, SCARISBRICK, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway in the West Lancashire Borough:
 - i. C137 Fish Lane, Burscough from C137 Berry House Road, Scarisbrick to the southern boundary of the property named Clay Brow Farm.
 - ii. C137 Berry House Road, Scarisbrick from C137 Fish Lane, Burscough to X4414 Wholesome Lane, Scarisbrick.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily between 0930 hours and 1500 hours from Monday 10th March 2025 until Friday 14th March 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained at all times.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closures is via:-

C137 Fish Lane, Burscough – C137 Tarlscough Lane, Burscough – C137 Red Cat Lane, South of Crabtree Farm – A59 Moss Lane, Burscough – A59 Causeway Lane, Rufford – A59 Liverpool Road, Rufford – B5248 Holmeswood Road, Rufford – C137 Wiggins Lane, Holmeswood – C137 Berry House Road, Scarisbrick and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow overhead works on the telegraph poles to be carried out by Sunbelt Rentals Ltd in conjunction with BT.
