- No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Cliff Street, Rishton at Gable End of 31 Lord Street in a southerly direction for a distance of 42 metres.

- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1408 hours on Monday 17th February 2025 until 2359 hours on Friday 21st February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow immediate works for open cut excavation to repair leaking service in carriageway to be carried out by United Utilities on behalf of Network Plus.
