- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Cowling Lane, Leyland from approximately the northeastern boundary of property number 13 to approximately the northeastern boundary of property number 27.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 1115 hours until 2359 hours on Tuesday 18th February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent sewer cleaning and surveying works to prevent foul flooding to be carried out by Sapphire Utility Solutions on behalf of United Utilities.
