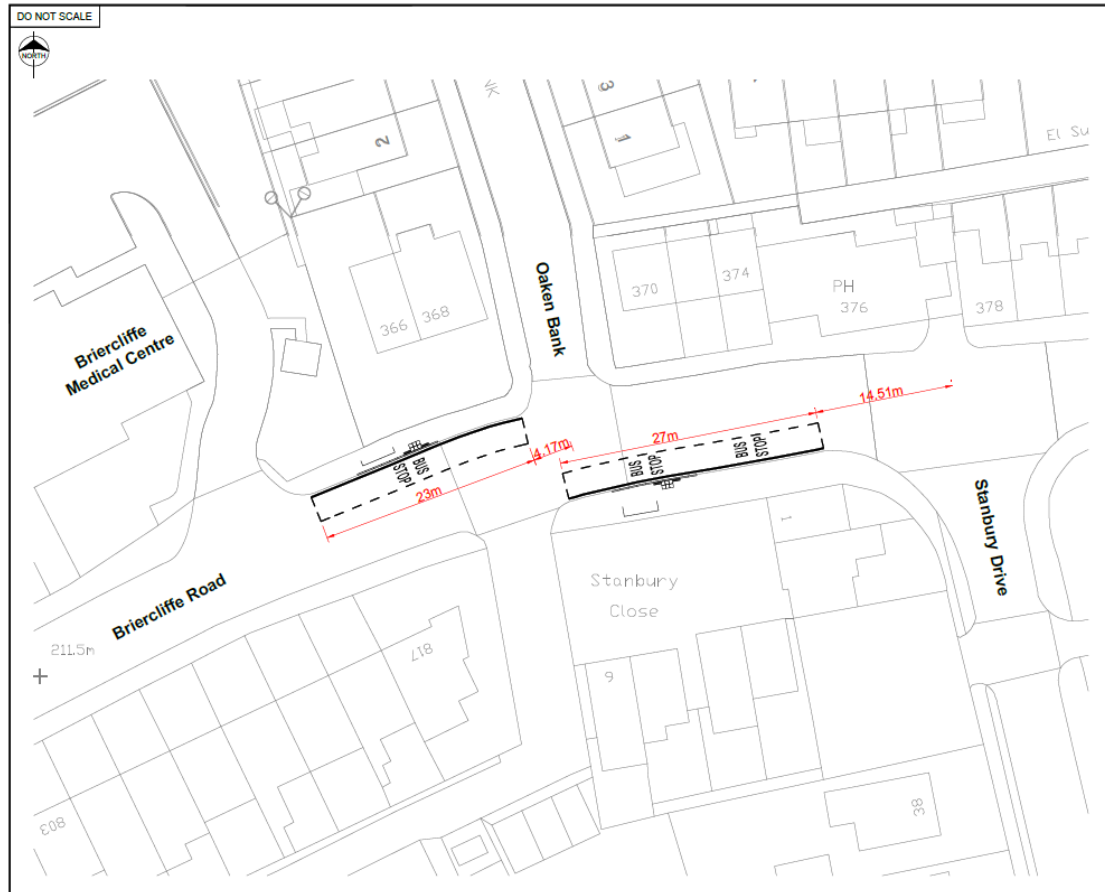


NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BRIERCLIFFE ROAD, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH) (BUS
STOP CLEARWAYS)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to introduce a Bus Stop Clearway at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in the following locations:

- Briercliffe Road, Burnley, the north west side, from a point 4.17 metres south west of its junction with the centreline of Oaken Bank for a distance of 23 metres in a south westerly direction;
- Briercliffe Road, Burnley, the south side, from a point 14.51 metres west of its junction with the centreline of Stanbury Drive for a distance of 27 metres in a westerly direction.

Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this proposal is to upgrade the existing bus stops on Briercliffe Road Burnley, with enforceable clearway markings and signs allowing buses to pull in safely and efficiently at the stop.

The proposal intends to promote sustainable transport for all users by including the construction of a raised platform, allowing safe boarding and alighting of passengers.

The proposals are being pursued as part of a s278 Agreement under the Highways Act 1980 as part of a new housing development.
