

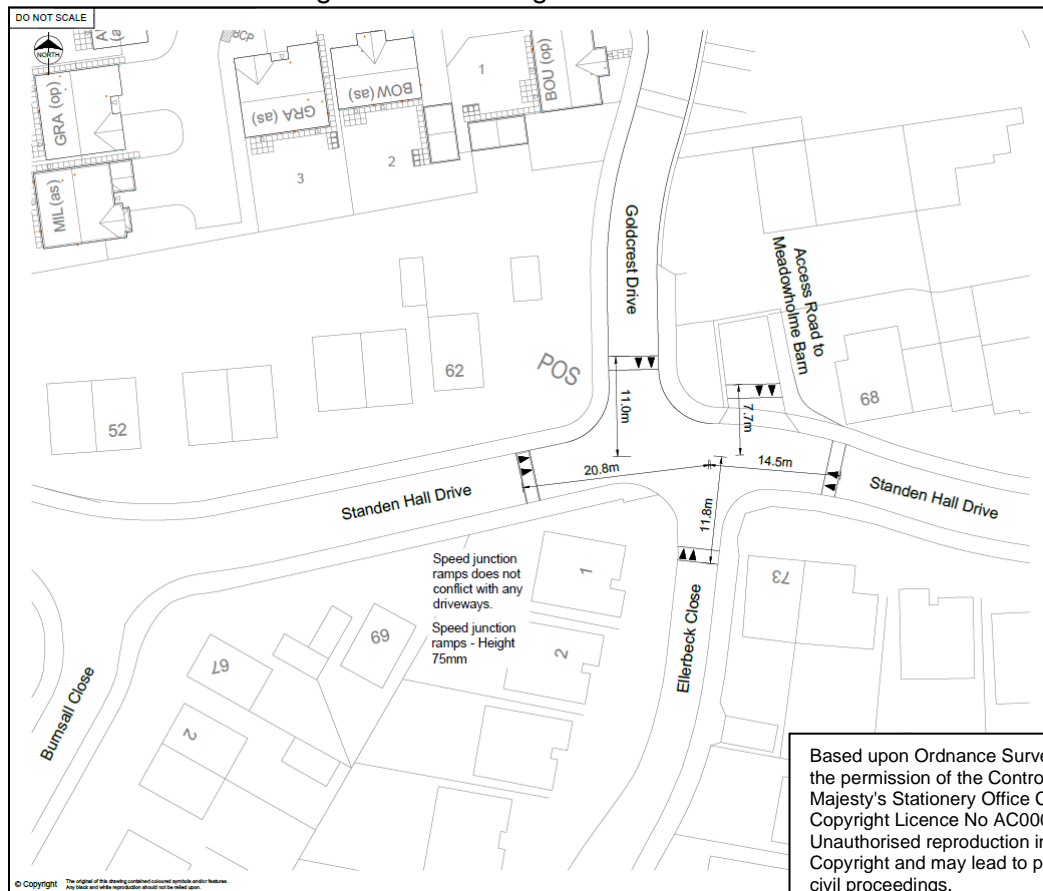
**NOTICE OF PROPOSAL  
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980  
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(STANDEN HALL DRIVE, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH) (JUNCTION  
TABLE)**



**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that in accordance with Section 90A of the **Highways Act 1980**, Lancashire County Council propose to introduce junction tables in the following locations:

- Standen Hall Drive, Burnley, from a point 20.8 metres west to a point 14.5 metres east of its junction with the centreline Ellerbeck Close;
- Goldcrest Drive, Burnley, from its junction with the centreline of Standen Hall Drive for a distance of 11 metres in a northerly direction;
- Ellerbeck Close, Burnley, from its junction with the centreline of Standen Hall Drive for a distance of 11.8 metres in a southerly direction;
- Access Road to Meadowholme Barn, Burnley, from its junction with the centreline of Standen Hall Drive for a distance of 7.7 metres in a northerly direction.

The junction table will have a maximum height not exceeding 75mm.



**Statement of Reasons**

The purpose of the junction table on Standen Hall Drive at the junctions with Ellerbeck Close and Goldcrest Drive is to slow traffic and allow safe passage of pedestrians due to the increase in traffic from the new housing development.

The proposals are being pursued as part of a s278 Agreement under the Highways Act 1980 as part of a new housing development.
