(SALT PIT LANE, MAWDESLEY, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Salt Pit Lane, Mawdesley from Blue Stone Lane, Mawdesley to Ridley Lane, Mawdesley.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily between 0800 hours and 1800 hours from Thursday 13th March 2025 until Friday 14th March 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Blue Stone Lane, Mawdesley – Dark Lane, Mawdesley – Ridley Lane, Mawdesley and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway surface dressing patching works to be carried out by Lancashire County Council.
