(BARNOLDSWICK ROAD, FOULRIDGE, PENDLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Barnoldswick Road, Foulridge from its junction with Standing Stone Lane to its junction with County Brook Lane.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on 17th March 2025 until 1700 hours on 25th March 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Manchester Road – Church Street – Skipton Road – Fernlea Avenue – Kelbrook Road – High Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Core Highways to carry out essential wall repair works.
