**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of U1168 Long Heys Lane, Dalton from a point approximately 55m Northeast of the property named Lower Orchard for an approximate distance of 60m in an Easterly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0940 hours on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> February 2025 until 2359 hours on Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. An alternative route for traffic affected by this closure is not possible owing to the fact that U1168 Long Heys Lane, Dalton is a no through road..

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent repair works to a leaking water service to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
