

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
(SABDEN ROAD, SIMONSTONE, RIBBLE VALLEY)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(b)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of Sabden Road, Simonstone from its junction with Back Lane to its junction with Whins Lane,
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours on 25<sup>th</sup> February 2025 until 1500 hours on 14<sup>th</sup> March 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained for residents and emergency services wherever and whenever possible. Access will be maintained for pedestrians.
4. Nothing in Article 1 of this Notice shall make it unlawful to proceed over the said road if the vehicle is being used for or in connection with the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the said road.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Back Lane – Trapp Lane – Whins Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Lancashire County Council to carry out urgent flood alleviation works to the carriageway and affected building.
