(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of G/E 26 Bird Street to G/E 29 Sefton Street, Brierfield from its junction with Bird Street to the side of 29a Sefton Street.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on 7<sup>th</sup> April 2025 until 1730 hours on 10<sup>th</sup> April 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Bird Street – Sefton Street

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Cadent Gas to install a new customer connection.
