NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose the following:

- 1) Remove a bus stop in Goosnargh Lane, Goosnargh, the north east side, from a point 123.4 metres south east of its junction with the projected centreline of Barnyard Way.
- 2) Remove a casual bus stop in Goosnargh Lane, Goosnargh, the south west side, from a point 123.4 metres south east of its junction with the centreline of Barnyard Way.
- 3) Introduce a Bus Stop Clearway at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in the following lengths of road:
 - a) Goosnargh Lane, Goosnargh, the north east side, from a point 9.5 metres south east of its junction with the projected centreline of Barnyard Way for a distance of 27 metres in a south easterly direction;
 - b) Goosnargh Lane, Goosnargh, the south west side, from a point 9.8 metres north west of its junction with the centreline of Barnyard Way for a distance of 27 metres in a north westerly direction.

Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this proposal is to remove the existing permanent and casual bus stops on Goosnargh Lane near the junction with Oakleaf Close and introduce 2 new relocated bus stop clearways. Due to the narrow width of the footway at the existing bus stop positions, it is proposed to relocate the bus stops in a westerly direction to provide full mobility compliant bus stop clearways.
