RING WAY JUNCTION SCHEME, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY (TEMPORARY PROHIBTION OF LEFT TURN) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. To temporarily prohibit any motor vehicle or cycle from turning left on that length of Church Street, Preston from its junction with A6 Stanley Street for a distance of 65 metres in a south westerly direction.
- 2. The prohibition in article 1 will be operative from 0900 hours on Monday 3rd March 2025 until 0600 hours on Friday 25th April 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 3. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of A6063 Ribbleton Lane from its junction with A6 Ring Way to its junction with A6063 Deepdale Road.
- 4. The prohibition in article 3 will be operative from 1900 hours until 0600 hours from Monday 3rd March 2025 until Friday 25th April 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 5. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 6. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 7. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Deepdale Road – Sir Tom Finney Way – Blackpool Road – Garstang Road – Moor Lane – North Road – Ring Way and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow traffic signal upgrade works to be carried out.
