HAIGHTON GREEN LANE, HAIGHTON, PRESTON CITY (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Haighton Green Lane, Haighton from outside of Seamark Farm to its junction with Boltons Fold.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours until 1530 hours on Monday 7th April 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Haighton Green Lane – Whittingham Lane – Preston Road – Longridge Road – Bluebell Way – Longsands Lane – Andertons Way – Eastway – Durton Lane – Haighton Green Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole testing works to be carried out.
