

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(SLINGER ROAD, THORNTON-CLEVELEYS, WYRE BOROUGH)
(PEDESTRIAN CROSSING)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above pedestrian crossing under Section 23 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a zebra crossing in Slinger Road, Thornton-Cleveleys, from a point 38.2 metres north east of its junction with Derby Road for a distance of 28.5 metres in a south westerly direction then continuing into Rough Lea Road in a southerly direction.
