(WOOD LANE, GREAT ALTCAR, WEST LANCASHIRE)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Wood Lane, Great Altcar from the entrance of property name Delph Farm to the entrance of property name New Hill House.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1500 on Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> May 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Causeway Lane – Broad Lane – Lord Sefton Way – Altcar Road – Formby Bypass – Liverpool Road – Liverpool Avenue – Segars Lane – Mill Road - Heathfield Road – Guildford Road – New Cut Lane – Gregory Lane – A5147 – Black-A-Moor Lane - Altcar Lane – Flatmans Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telegraph replacement works to be carried out.
