**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Sandy Lane, Aughton from Bold Lane, Aughton to Mickering Lane, Aughton.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1305 hours on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> March 2025 until 2359 hours on Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. Access for emergency services will not be maintained due to the nature of works making safe passage not possible.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent drainage repair works to a broken culvert to be carried out by Lancashire County Council.
