

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
BRUNSHAW AVENUE, BURNLEY BOROUGH
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Brunshaw Avenue, Burnley from its junction with Brunshaw Road to its junction with Lyndhurst Road.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours to 1600 on Monday 14th April 2025 until Friday 18th April 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Brunshaw Avenue – Brunshaw Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway drainage works to be carried out.
