

**cLANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
(DALTON STREET, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Dalton Street, Burnley from its junction with Coal Clough Lane to its junction with Fenwick Street.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> April 2025 until 1700 hours on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> April 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: Coal Clough Lane - Cog Lane - Woodcourt Avenue - Dalton Street and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow utility maintenance works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of Electricity Northwest.
