NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Neps Lane and Kiln Lane, Paythorne from their junction with Settle Road travelling in a westerly direction to a point north west of Paythorne Bridge.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0000 hours on 22nd March 2025 until 2359 hours on 9th May 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Settle Road – Hellifield Road – Settle Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Lancashire County Council to complete urgent bridge repair work.
