NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE. The grid lines form part of the National Grid and are at 100 metre intervals. To give a unique reference to a point on the map, the grid square reference is given by the letters of the grid square in which the point lies.

AREAS. Area measurement is to plan edge only. The number and area, in hectares (ha) and acres, is shown within each parcel of land. EXAMPLE: 1:899ha area in hectares, 4:47 area in acres.

Includes entries for Non-coniferous trees, Coniferous trees, Orchard trees, Coppice, Scrub, Haugh, Bracken, rough grassland, Saltings, estuaries, saltmarsh, Slopes, Cliff, Cave entrance, Rock, Boulder, Scaffolding, Stopping masonry, Travelling station, Travelling station (park), Surface level, Revision point, Revision point and bench mark coincident.
