


LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(COMMON GARDEN STREET, LANCASTER, LANCASTER CITY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Common Graden Street, Lancaster from its junction with A6 King Street to its junction with Russel Street.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 1900 hours until 2300 hours on Thursday 8th May 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents and emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
A6 King Street – A6 China Street – A6 Bridge Lane – A6 Cable Street – A6 North Road – A6 Rosemary Lane – A6 Stonewell – A6 Great John Street – A6 Dalton Square.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow works to reset inspection chamber fame and cover be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United utilities.
