(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Front of Blackpool Road Nos 689 to 765, Preston from its junction with Blam Avenue to its junction with Weeton Place.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2025 until 1700 hours on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> June 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Ballam Avenue – Norbreck Drive – Layton Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to lay multiple ducts for plain lead cable replacement for approximately 150 metres to be carried out.
