

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
BOOTH STREET, RAWTENSTALL. ROSSENDALE BOROUGH  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Booth Street, Rawtenstall from its junction with Burnley Road East for 10 metres in an easternly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1500 hours on Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> April or until completion of the works within this period.  
**Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow maintenance of SLM equipment in CSO chamber works to be carried out by Sapphire Utility Solutions on behalf of United Utilities.
