(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of
  - i. Blackburn Road, Accrington Hyndburn from its junction of King Street to its junction with Edgar Street.
  - ii. King Street, Accrington, Hyndburn from its junction with Hyndburn Road to its junction under the railway bridge.
  - iii. Hyndburn Road, Accrington, Hyndburn from its junction with Ashfield Road to its junction with Devonshire Road.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 2200 hours until 0600 hours on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2025 to Thursday 5th June 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-


Blackburn Road, Accrington, King Street- Eastgate-Abbey Street-  
Spring Gardens-Wellington Street-Church Street-Paradise Street-Eagle  
Street-  
Blackburn Road.

King Street, Accrington, Hyndburn Road-Oxford Street-Blackburn Road.

Hyndburn Road, Accrington, King Street-Blackburn Road-Oxford Street-  
Hyndburn Road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow full road closure for bridge examination works to be carried out by Centurion Traffic Management on behalf of Bridgeway Consulting Limited.
