(WISWELL LANE, WHALLEY AND WHALLEY EASTERLY BYPASS, WISWELL, RIBBLE VALLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF LEFT TURN) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURN) NOTICE 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Wiswell Lane, Whalley from Whalley Easterly Bypass, Wiswell to Springfield Road, Whalley

AND FURTHER, no person shall cause any motor vehicle with the exception of emergency service vehicles proceeding in a northbound direction from making a left turn from Whalley Easterly Bypass, Wiswell onto Wiswell Lane, Whalley

AND FURTHER, no person shall cause any motor vehicle with the exception of emergency service vehicles proceeding in a southbound direction from making a right turn from Whalley Easterly Bypass, Wiswell onto Wiswell Lane, Whalley.

2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours on Thursday 27th March 2025 until 1600 hours on Friday 28th March 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
Access for emergency service vehicles will be maintained at all times.
4. Alternative routes for traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Westbound Traffic

Whalley Easterly Bypass, Wiswell - A59 Whalley Clitheroe Bypass Roundabout – Whalley Easterly Bypass, Wiswell – Accrington Road, Whalley – King Street, Whalley – Cltheroe Road, Whalley – Wiswell Lane, Whalley

Eastbound Traffic

Whalley Easterly Bypass, Wiswell – Accrington Road, Whalley – King Street, Whalley – Cltheroe Road, Whalley – Wiswell Lane, Whalley

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent reactive patching works to be carried out by Lancashire County Council.
