

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
BELVEDERE ROAD, BURNLEY BOROUGH  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Belvedere Road, Burnley from its junction with Queen Victoria Road to outside number 144.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The Order will be in force daily from 0900 hours until 1500 hours on Monday 28<sup>th</sup> April 2025 to Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Queen Victoria Road – Eastern Avenue – Casterton Avenue – Colne Road – Church Street – Yorkshire Street – Belvedere Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out by Lancashire County Council.
