(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit any motor vehicle, cycle or pedestrian (except for filming participants) from proceeding over those lengths of highway in the borough of Burnley;

- i. Crown Point Road, from its junction with Woodplumpton Road for 60 metres in a westerly direction.

Access will be maintained for residents, businesses and emergency services.

The Police, Fire and Ambulance Services have been informed.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to enable the filming of the television series "Brassic".

The prohibition will be operative from 1300 hours until 2359 hours on Tuesday 8th April 2025. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

The alternative routes for vehicular traffic affected by the closures are via.

Crown Point Road – A671 Todmorden Road – A646 New Road – Woodplumpton Road.
