(U303 NEW LANE, BURSCOUGH, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025


NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of U303 New Lane, Burscough from U3617 Marsh Moss Lane, Burscough to the northwestern boundary of property number 123.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0025 hours until 0700 hours on Sunday 27th April 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
Access for emergency services will be maintained at all times.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

U3617 Marsh Moss Lane, Burscough – C137 Tarlsough Lane,
Burscough – C137 Red Cat Lane, South of Crabtree Lane – A59
Liverpool Road North, Burscough – A59 Liverpool Road South,
Burscough – U300 Higgins Lane, Burscough – U303 New Lane,
Burscough and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow level crossing removal and replacement works to be carried out by Centurion Traffic Management in conjunction with Network Rail.
