NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Rear 21 to 35 Lansdowne Road, Burnley from outside 27 for 10 metres in either direction.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1500 hours on Monday 7th April 2025 until 2359 hours on Friday 11th April 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent excavation works required to repair sewer in the carriageway works to be carried out by Sapphire Utility Solutions on behalf of United Utilities.
