

**NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BARKERHOUSE ROAD AND SMITH STREET, NELSON, PENDLE
BOROUGH) (JUNCTION TABLE)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in accordance with Section 90A of the **Highways Act 1980**, Lancashire County Council propose to introduce a junction table in the following locations:

- 1) Barkerhouse Road, Nelson, from the intersection of the centreline of Smith Street and Barkerhouse Road for a distance of 14.1 metres in a westerly direction.
- 2) Barkerhouse Road, Nelson, from the intersection of the centreline of Smith Street and Barkerhouse Road for a distance of 9.5 metres in an easterly direction.
- 3) Smith Street, Nelson, from the intersection of the centreline of Smith Street and Barkerhouse Road for a distance of 10.4 metres in a northerly direction.

The junction table will have a maximum height not exceeding 75 mm.



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Statement of Reasons

The proposals are being pursued as part of making Lancashire safer. It was requested that the existing Zebra Crossing be upgraded on Barkerhouse Road, Nelson and a junction table be installed. Making it safer for pedestrians using the crossing. The proposals include an introduction of a raised junction table at the junction on Barkerhouse Road. The purpose of this is to slow down traffic and allow safe passage of pedestrians due to the increase in traffic coming in and out of the town centre of Nelson. The proposal has been introduced due to serious accidents involving pedestrians at the crossing.
