

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(HIGHER LANE, UP HOLLAND, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Higher Lane, Up Holland from outside number 40 Higher Lane to its junction with Church Street.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 3rd March until 1800 hours on Wednesday 4th March 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -
Church Street, A577 Parliament Street, A577 Grove Road, A577 Dingle Road, Hall Green, Alma Hill, Higher Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow remedial works to rectify a defect to be carried out.
