


**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
(BARKERHOUSE ROAD, NELSON, PENDLE BOROUGH)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Barkerhouse Road, Nelson from approximately 5 meters easterly from its junction Wren Street to approximately 10 metres westerly from its junction with Smith Street.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative nightly from 2200 hours until 0600 hours on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> February 2026 until Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. Works are weather dependent and may be carried out on any of the dates specified.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-  
Town House Road – Walton Lane – Leeds Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow major resurfacing works to be carried out.
