(SOLLom LANE, LOCK LANE, TARLETON, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway:
 - I. Sollom Lane, Tarleton from its merging with Lock Lane, Tarleton for a distance of 40 metres in a southeast direction.
 - II. Lock Lane, Tarleton from its merging with Sollom Lane, Tarleton for a distance of 10 metres in a westerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Friday 23rd January 2026 until 1700 hours on Tuesday 27th January 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Lock Lane – Liverpool Old Road - A59 Liverpool Road - A59 Windgate - A59 Bank Bridge - A59 Liverpool Road - B5247 Carr House Lane - B5247 South Road – Back Lane – Eyes Lane – Sollom Lane and Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow installation and new connection works to be carried out.
