Inspired by the Bayeux Tapestry, the Quaker Tapestry was begun in 1981 by a boy and his teacher. The 77 vibrant embroidered panels were made by 4,000 men, women and children from 15 countries between 1981 and 1996. The panels depict scenes from Quaker life, history, services and pilgrimages. There is excellent provision for school visits which can be linked to RE, art and history.
