(HAWTHORN AVENUE SCHEME, OSWALDTWISTLE, HYNDBURN BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council intends to make an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway in the Borough of Hyndburn
 - i. Hawthorn Avenue, Oswaldtwistle from its junction with The Meadows to its junction with Melrose Avenue.
 - ii. Durham Drive, Oswaldtwistle from its junction with Hawthorn Avenue for a distance of 20 metres in a westerly direction.
 - iii. Fern Avenue, Oswaldtwistle from its junction with Hawthorn Avenue for a distance of 20 metres in an easterly direction.
 - iv. Melrose Avenue, Oswaldtwistle from its junction with Hawthorn Avenue to its junction with High Street.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The Order will be in force from 0800 hours on Wednesday 6th April until 1700 hours on Friday 1st May 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow mains replacement works to be carried out by Cadent Gas.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closures will be:

Hawthorn Avenue -Melrose Avenue and vice versa.

Durham Drive diversion via High Street - Queens Drive - Hawthorn Avenue - Melrose Avenue and vice versa.

Fern Avenue diversion via Yew Tree Drive – High Street and vice versa.

Melrose Avenue diversion via High Street - Yew Tree Drive - Hawthorn Avenue -Melrose Avenue and vice versa.
