(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over those lengths of
 - i. Oxcliffe Road, Heaton With Oxcliffe from its junction with Westcliffe Drive to its junction with White Lund Road.
 - ii. Mellishaw Lane, Heaton With Oxcliffe from its junction with White Lund Road to its junction with Southgate.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0900 hours until 1500 hours on Tuesday 28th April 2026 until Thursday 30th April 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent carriageway pre-surfacing dressing patch work to be carried out.
