

NOTICE OF MODIFICATION ORDER

SECTION 53 OF THE WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

THE DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT OF PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY FOR THE COUNTY OF LANCASHIRE

THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL ADDITION OF FOOTPATH FROM CHATBURN OLD ROAD, CHATBURN DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2022

The above Order, made on the 25 January 2023, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the area, by recording a footpath from a junction with the western end of unclassified road U22924 (Chatburn Old Road) running in a westerly direction along the tarmac road for a distance of 50 metres and then turning south to pass through a metal kissing gate and continuing to the east of the boundary fence separating the land crossed by the Order route with the disused limestone quarry for a distance of 100 metres and then turning to continue east across open land for a further 90 metres to the unmarked junction with Footpaths 3-11-FP1 and 3-11-FP13. The total length of the route is 0.24 kilometres and the width of the route varies between 2 and 7 metres.

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (RIBCHESTER ROAD, CLAYTON LE DALE / WILPSHIRE, RIBBLE VALLEY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Ribchester Road, Clayton le Dale / Wilpsire, from its junction with Whalley Road to its junction with Salesbury Hall Road (Ribchester Bridge).
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The Order will be in force daily from 0600 hours to 2000 hours on 12th June 2023 to 7th July 2023 or until completion of the works within this period. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closures will be locally signed.
5. Pedestrian access to premises on or adjacent to the road will not be prohibited by any provision of this order.
