(DRUMACRE LANE WEST, LONGTON, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

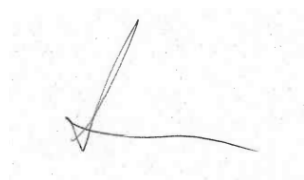
1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Drumacre Lane West, Longton from a point 100 metres east from its junction with Liverpool Road, Longton for a distance of 220 metres in an easterly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0830 hours until 1630 hours on Thursday 27th August 2026 until Friday 28th August 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Drumacre Lane West – Liverpool Road – Liverpool Old Road – Gill Lane - A59 Longton Bypass.

Drumacre Lane West - A59 Longton Bypass – Chapel Lane – Liverpool Road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telecom pole maintenance works to be carried out.
