ADDITION OF FOOTPATH FROM CHATBURN OLD ROAD, CHATBURN
DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2022**

This Order is made by Lancashire County Council ("the authority") under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act, 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Lancashire require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(b) and 53(3)(c)(i) namely the discovery by the Surveying Authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, namely a public footpath.

The authority have consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. Lancashire County Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this Order, the "relevant date" is 25 January 2023.
2. The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Lancashire shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as The Lancashire County Council Addition of Footpath from Chatburn Old Road, Chatburn Definitive Map Modification Order 2022.

SCHEDULE

PART I

MODIFICATION OF THE DEFINITIVE MAP

DESCRIPTION OF PATH OR WAY TO BE ADDED

Footpath from a junction with the western end of unclassified road U22924 (Chatburn Old Road) (point A on the Order Map) running in a westerly direction along the tarmac road for a distance of 50 metres and then turning south to pass through a metal kissing gate (point B) and continuing to the east of the boundary fence separating the land crossed by the Order route with the disused limestone quarry for a distance of 100 metres and then turning (point C) to continue east across open land for a further 90 metres to the unmarked junction with Footpaths 3-11-FP1 and 3-11-FP13 (point D).

The route is shown on the Order Map between points A-B-C-D as a thick broken dashed line.

The total length of the route is 0.24 kilometres and the width of the route varies between 2 and 7 metres.

MODIFICATION OF DEFINITIVE STATEMENT

VARIATION OF PARTICULARS OF PATH OR WAY

The Statement to be added for Chatburn 16 to read as follows:

Kind of path: "Footpath"

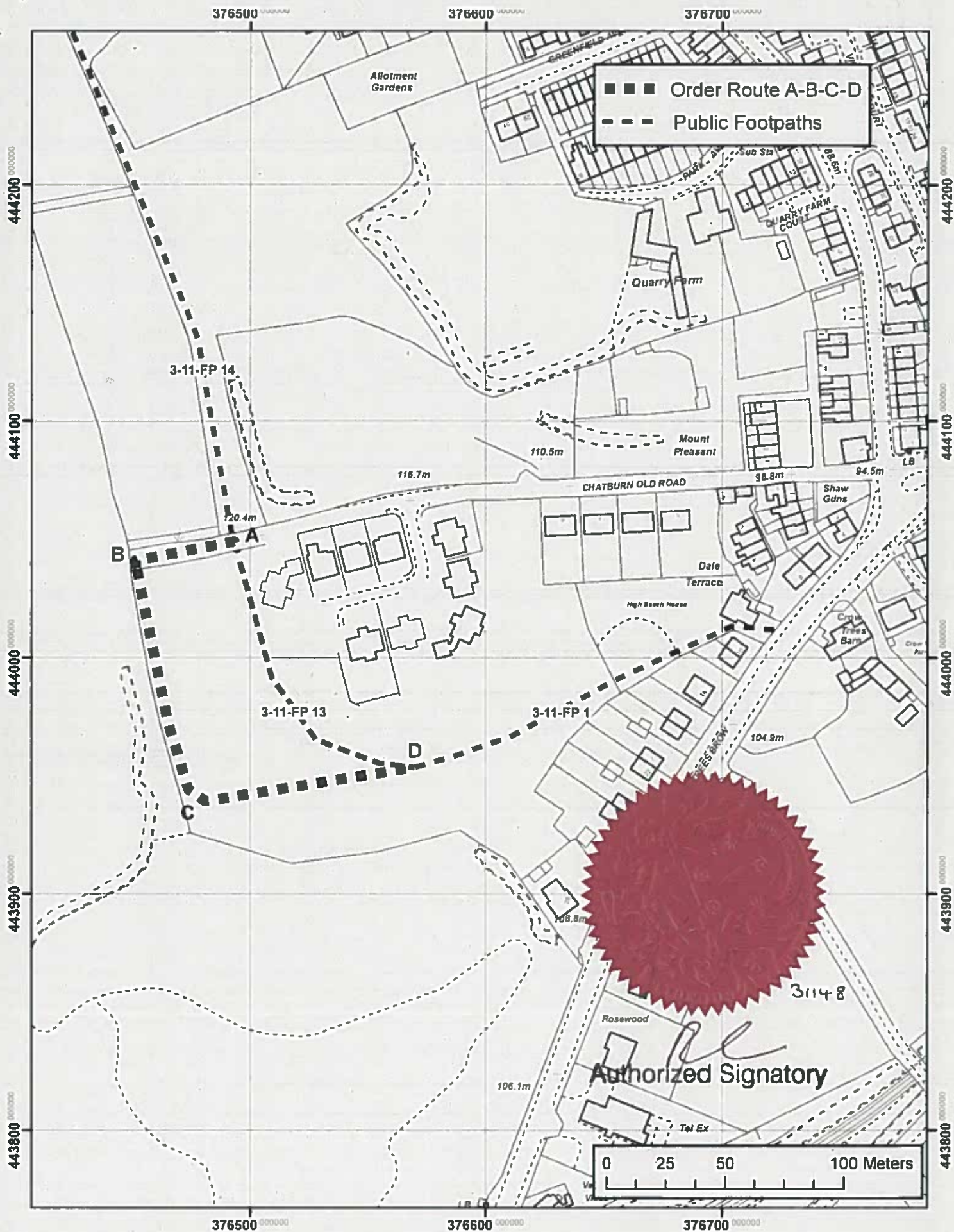
Position: "Footpath from a junction with the eastern end of Chatburn Old Road and Footpaths 3-11-FP13 and 3-11-FP14 at Grid Reference SD 7649 4404 running in a westerly direction for a distance of 50 metres and then turning to pass through a metal kissing gate at SD 7645 4403 to continue in a southerly direction east of the boundary fence separating the land crossed by the footpath with the disused limestone quarry for a distance of 100 metres to SD 7647 4394 and then turning to continue east across open land for a further 90 metres to the unmarked junction with Footpaths 3-11-FP1 and 3-11-FP13 at SD 7656 4395.

All compass directions given are approximate."

Length: "0.24 km"

Width: "Width between SD 7649 4404 and SD 7645 4403 – 7 metres and between SD 7645 4403 and SD 7656 4395 – 2 metres."

Limitations: Kissing Gate at SD 7645 4403"

Kind of path: "Footpath"

Position: "Footpath from a junction with the eastern end of Chatburn Old Road and Footpaths 3-11-FP13 and 3-11-FP14 at Grid Reference SD 7649 4404 running in a westerly direction for a distance of 50 metres and then turning to pass through a metal kissing gate at SD 7645 4403 to continue in a southerly direction east of the boundary fence separating the land crossed by the footpath with the disused limestone quarry for a distance of 100 metres to SD 7647 4394 and then turning to continue east across open land for a further 90 metres to the unmarked junction with Footpaths 3-11-FP1 and 3-11-FP13 at SD 7656 4395.

All compass directions given are approximate."

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Width: "Width between SD 7649 4404 and SD 7645 4403 – 7 metres and between SD 7645 4403 and SD 7656 4395 – 2 metres."

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
