STATEMENT CONTAINING THE ORDER MAKING AUTHORITY'S
COMMENTS ON THE OBJECTIONS

ORDER MAKING AUTHORITY NOT SUPPORTING THE ORDER

Lancashire County Council is the Order Making Authority ("the OMA) for the above Order.

The County Council's Regulatory Committee, at its meeting on 11 September 2013, resolved that, not being satisfied that the higher test for confirming the said Order could be satisfied, the said Order, if objected to, be submitted to the Secretary of State for formal determination and the County Council as the OMA remain neutral as regards confirmation.

One objection was received from Lancashire County Council (as landowner) together with Moorside Primary School.

The County Council as the OMA are therefore submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for formal determination and notifying the Secretary of State that it does not actively support the Order and is adopting a "neutral stance" as regards confirmation of the Order. As such the OMA does not have any comments on the objections made to the Order.
