**THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL PUBLIC FOOTPATH FROM BARTON ROAD
TO BOWERHAM ROAD, SCOTFORTH (DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION) ORDER
2013**

This Order is made by Lancashire County Council ("the Authority") under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act, 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that Authority that The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Lancashire require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(c)(i) namely the discovery by the Surveying Authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, namely a public footpath

The Authority have consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. Lancashire County Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this Order, the "relevant date" is the 27th November 2013.
2. The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Lancashire shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as The Lancashire County Council Public Footpath from Barton Road to Bowerham Road, Scotforth (Definitive Map Modification) Order 2013.

SCHEDULE

PART I

MODIFICATION OF THE DEFINITIVE MAP

DESCRIPTION OF PATH OR WAY TO BE ADDED

A Public Footpath to start from Barton Road opposite Durham Avenue (point A), it then crosses the playing field in an east-south-easterly direction for 140m and crosses Burrow Beck via informal stepping stones (point B). It then continues east for 150m and passes through a gap in a hedge (point C) and a further 75m across Moorside Primary School playing field to meet a 3m wide tarmac path (point F). It follows the tarmac path east-north-east for 180m to end at Bowerham Road (point G).

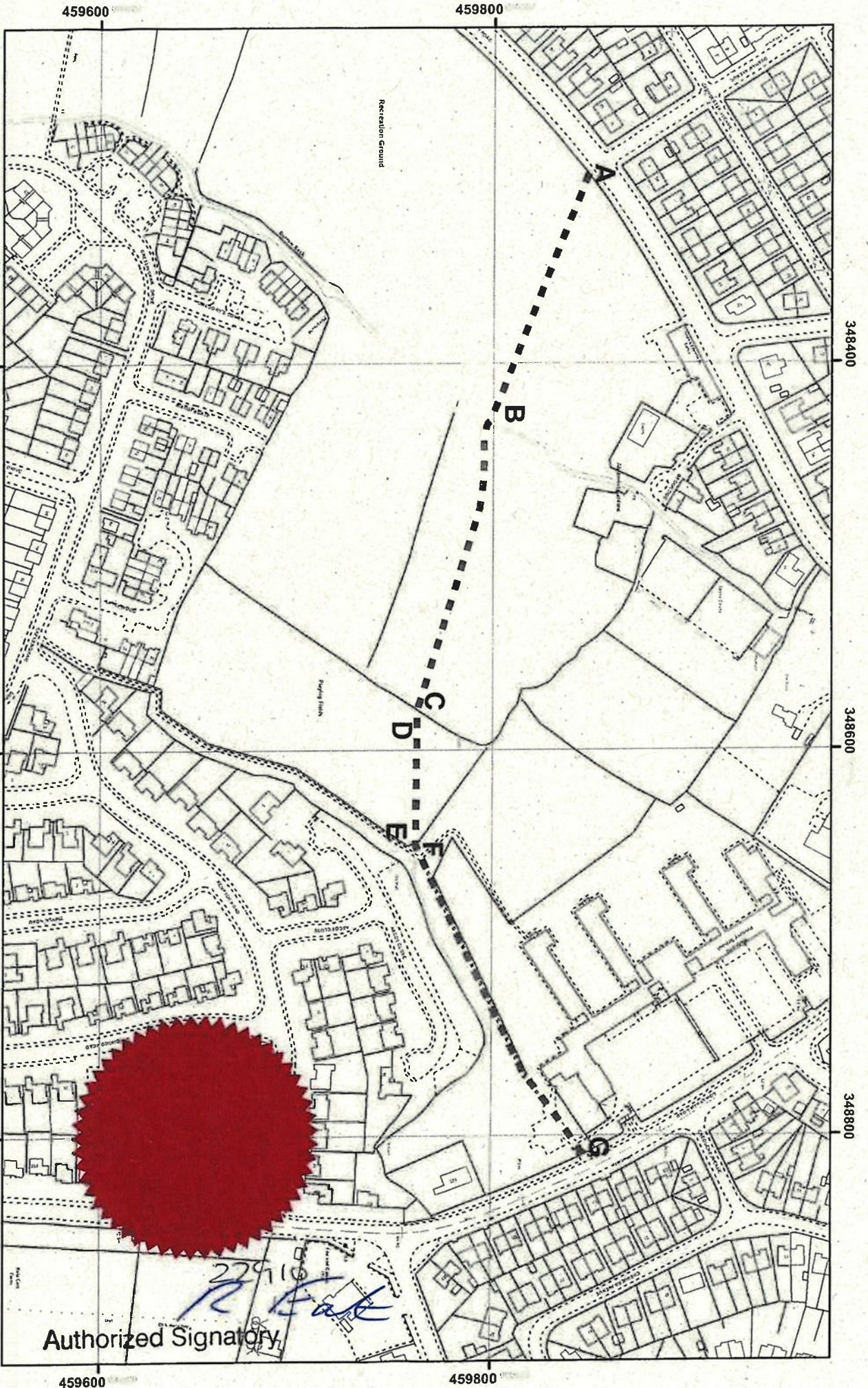
MODIFICATION OF DEFINITIVE STATEMENT

VARIATION OF PARTICULARS OF PATH OR WAY

Public footpath from a point on Barton Road opposite Durham Avenue at SD 4830 5984 in an east-south-easterly direction for 140m to informal stepping stones over Burrow Beck at SD 4843 5979; continuing in a generally easterly direction for 150m, through a gap in the hedge then a further 75m across the Moorside Primary School playing field to the tarmac track at SD 4865 5975. It follows the tarmac track east-north-east for 180m to end at a junction with Bowerham Road at SD 4881 5984. Total length 545m.

(All lengths, in metres, and compass directions given are approximate.)
The width is 1.5m from A-F but 3m F-G

There are no limitations to the public right of way
