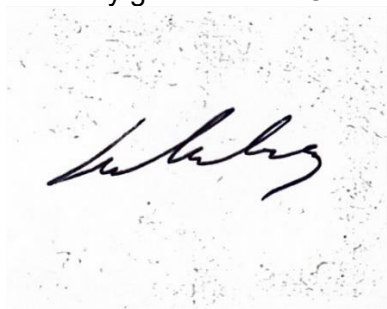
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over those lengths of
 - i. **Knotts Lane, Colne** from its junction with The Old Brickworks to its junction with Southfield Lane.
 - ii. **Southfield Lane, Colne** from its junction with Knotts Lane to its junction with Back Lane
 - iii. **Back Lane, Colne** from its junction with Southfield Lane to its junction with Sheffield Lane
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0600 hours until 1800 hours on Saturday 8th August 2026 until Sunday 6th September 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. Works are weather dependent and may be carried out on any of the dates specified.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Delves Lane – Southfield Lane – Barkerhouse Road – Leeds Road – Burnley Road, Colne – Knotts Lane – Bridge Street – Albert Road - Church Street, Colne – Market Street – Keighley Road – Cotton Tree Lane – Skipton Road – Church Street, Trawden – Burnley Road, Trawden – Sheffield Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow surface dressing carriageway works to be carried out by Lancashire County Council.
