

NOTICE OF MAKING
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BARKERHOUSE ROAD, NELSON, PENDLE BOROUGH) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LIMITED WAITING) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 14th September 2026 Lancashire County Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to:

- 1) Introduce a prohibition of waiting in Barkerhouse Road, Nelson, the south side, from a point 29 metres west of the centreline of its junction with Pine Street for a distance of 41.7 metres in a north westerly direction.
- 2) Introduce a limited waiting parking place for 30 minutes with no return within 2 hours Monday to Saturday 8am – 6pm in Barkerhouse Road, Nelson, the south side, from a point 17.5 metres south east of its junction with the centreline of Smith Street for a distance of 20 metres in a south easterly direction.

This Order will come into force on the 28th September 2026. A copy of the Order, and all other relevant documents may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of Pendle Borough Council, No1 Market Street, Nelson, Lancashire, BB9 9LU, and at the offices of The Director of Law and Governance, Lancashire County Council, County Hall, PO Box 100, Preston PR1 0LD, and on Lancashire County Councils Website <https://www.lancashire.gov.uk/roads-parking-and-travel/roads/roadworks-and-traffic-regulation-orders/permanent-traffic-regulation-orders/>, quoting ref: **LSG4/894_21137/AFR**. Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
